

**RESOLUTION NO. 2009.07 MWC**

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF  
RUBIO CAÑÓN LAND & WATER ASSOCIATION ADOPTING A  
MANDATORY WATER CONSERVATION PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Rubio Cañon Land & Water Association (the "Association") is a mutual water company empowered to provide water service within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, due to a prolonged drought condition and other issues affecting the deliveries of imported water to Southern California, the Association will likely face water shortages in the near future; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors has adopted Ordinance No. 2008-00052U, establishing water conservation requirements for the unincorporated areas of Los Angeles County, including the area served by the Association; and

WHEREAS, in order to help implement the County's ordinance, the Association finds it necessary to adopt and implement a mandatory water conservation program,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Association hereby adopts a mandatory water conservation program pursuant to Los Angeles County Ordinance No. 2008-00052U, with a goal of reducing water use by twenty percent (20%) or more; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Association directs its customers to:

- a. Adjust sprinklers and irrigation systems to avoid overspray, runoff and waste;
- b. Not water lawns between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.;
- c. Shut off decorative fountains, ponds, or other similar aesthetic features, unless a water recycling system is used;
- d. Not hose down driveways, sidewalks and other paved surfaces, except when necessary for health or sanitary reasons;
- e. Not allow the hose to run while washing any vehicle and to use a bucket or a hose with an automatic cutoff valve;
- f. Check faucets, toilets and pipes, both indoor and outdoor, including house service laterals and sprinkler piping, for leaks and repair them immediately, or upon demand of the Association.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that restaurants and other public places where food is served are hereby directed to serve drinking water to customers only when specifically requested to do so by the customer.
